RBB was commissioned by UCLA for the renovation and relocation of services from the Center for Health Sciences to the 200 Medical Plaza building. The \$12 million project relocates the Cobalt Therapy Unit and Nuclear Medicine department. The renovation project also includes a 21,000 SF outpatient surgery expansion and relocates Clark Urological Procedures Unit on the sixth floor. Key Components include:

- 31 Recovery beds
- Phased Renovation
